

Your Employers Commitment



To support your apprenticeship your employer will be expected to:

- Work with TLC to identify the most suitable apprenticeship standard.
- Provide assistance to TLC during eligibility checks.
- Confirm that TLC has made the appropriate checks on your behalf.
- Negotiate a price with TLC, taking into account your prior learning, and understand any obligations in relation to co-investment.
- Choose an end-point assessment organisation (at least 3 months prior to the end of the programme).
- Contribute to and agree to the plan of training, as developed by TLC.
- Deliver off-the-job training (where agreed and detailed in the plan of training).
- Provide you with opportunities to practise new skills in the work environment.
- Assist TLC in collecting evidence of off-the-job training (where information is held by the employer) .
- Contribute to tripartite progress reviews with you and provider.
- Agree, with you and provider, when learning is complete and you is ready to undertake the end-point assessment.
- Seek to resolve any complaints brought by you or TLC.
