Dear Mentor,

Thank you very much for agreeing to support a colleague within your workplace as they study for their Apprenticeship within the adult health and social care sector with TLC.

Your colleague or employee has recognised that you have the skills, experience and knowledge to support them whilst they study for a vocational based apprenticeship within the adult social care sector. You may have one or more students that you are mentoring, and these may require different areas of support depending on their time and experience within the role. Your student has been asked to consider the support they might need and this could range from the discussion of assignments and knowledge, to sharing your expertise or skills in a more practical way. You will also be asked to provide witness testimonies as evidence to prove that they are competent in a range of skills and support them to locate other product evidence to help demonstrate this and to build their portfolio in readiness for their end point assessment.
